## MISSIONARY UPDATE: SAM + RANDI EDELSTEIN LOCATION: MINNESOTA

Dear Friends,

Happy New Year – may it be your best yet! We are SO grateful for your prayers, which we truly believe have helped our family experience God's goodness and grace!

Dan & Kerah, along with Josiah, Stefen & Sage, enjoy baseball, traveling, and hiking on the North Shore of MN, in Colorado, and in new places they discover together. They are currently training couples to support other couples in four churches, using various materials. Dan also leads a Bible study at the local jail. Professionally, Dan administers health clinics, and Kerah substitute teaches in her children's classrooms.

Kerby & Cristina, with Vivi, Lucy, Chago & Millie, will soon help build two homes in Mexico alongside more than 50 team members, family, and friends. Their team sold 904 homes last year. In addition, they run a lending business and market a real estate software that they have developed. Their family also enjoys many fun activities while traveling together. Our family often gathers at their peaceful lake cabin about an hour north of Minneapolis.

Sam & Jeanette and their children, Karis, Simon & Noah, have adapted well to life in Oklahoma. They are connected to a strong church community, and the kids are involved in youth groups. Their life group, which includes an Iranian couple, has led to meaningful and vulnerable interactions. Sam will be speaking at an upcoming men's retreat, while Jeanette practices art therapy, which helps others engage in deeper dialogue. Sam also continues to develop software for Kerby's company.

Amy serves weekly as a charge nurse at Hennepin County's largest clinic, where she uses her Spanish daily. This year, she finished sixth in the world in her Ninja category, hiked in Alaska with us, and completed three days of extreme jogging—40 miles in 3 days (3 different times!)—in the mountains of national parks in California and Utah. She also participates in Torah Bible studies and Sabbath dinners.

Sam & Randi celebrated their 50th anniversary in special ways: their first-ever cruise (through Alaska's Inside Passage), a family reunion in Colorado, and time together at the cabin. As we learn to live with some physical limitations, we continue to walk almost daily—even in the Minnesota winter—using mini spikes and ski poles when needed. Many family members chose a keyword for 2026: Sam's is *renew*, and Randi's is *intentional*.
