Hello, Friends!

Funny to be writing to you this time from right here in the US! I'm so thankful to be safely here for a month with Brandon after being apart for a month. Below you'll find other current praises and prayer requests for our family. Thank you so much for keeping us in your prayers during this crazy time of transition. We are truly grateful!

#### PRAISES

-This past month, with the kids and I having to be apart from Brandon, went surprisingly well! We could definitely tell people were praying for us, as the Lord gave us comfort and peace during separation.

-I arrived in MN on March 31<sup>st</sup> and happily reunited with my sweet husband!

-Jesus surprised us with a beautiful blessing right after I arrived. We discovered that a stranger had paid for our lodging while we were in Rochester for my medical treatment!

-Mayo has been able to schedule me for numerous helpful appointments for my health issues; appointments will continue next week. In addition, they have been willing to see Brandon for intense back pain that has been a long-term concern for him.

-Wedding planning is coming along nicely; in spite of different time zones, I am able to help Nikayla and Tyler with decisions for their special day.
