MISSIONARY UPDATE: RAY + DORIS RISING

LOCATION: USA, COLOMBIA, PERU, VENEZUELA, BOLIVIA

Dear Friends,

Time seems to pass quickly these days and we need to catch you up with our projects of the year.

In March, Galen Stutzman (Lomalinda colleague) and I went to Chazuta, Peru to work on the short-wave transmitters for Radio Logos that broadcasts to the northern jungle area where there are 17 languages, so it's important to keep them on the air broadcasting the Good News. Galen was a tremendous help. We had to redo some of the work the local technician did but he was very grateful for the one on one training he received as they worked on the transmitters. Hopefully, with the WhatsApp, Ray can help him with problems before they become major ones.

June 1st, Ray traveled to Colombia so he could renew his resident visa only to find out that he has to reapply and hire an agency to help. This is in process.

The highlight while in Colombia was to fly to Leticia, which is a Colombian port on the Amazon River.

When we still lived in Colombia, Ray helped SIL set up a recording studio for the Ticuna who have a ministry in Brazil, Peru, and Colombia as the countries border each other at that point. He was delighted to see they have kept the place in good shape. They took him on a river trip to several villages and introduced him to some new believers who came to know the Lord through their music ministry.

Family news: In May, we made a trip to Columbus, IN. for the graduation of our granddaughter, Ann Marie from Purdue University.

Our youngest granddaughter, Lilianna, graduated from high school in May but we were unable to attend. In June, we traveled to Wichita, KS for our grandson, Cooper and Aubrey's wedding June 20th and on June 24th our granddaughter, Alyssa and Calvin's wedding! Quite a busy time!

Ray keeps getting good reports both on his eyes and after his prostate cancer. Doris is now having injections to treat macular degeneration in her eyes. It's frustrating having blurry vision and using a magnifying glass to read. Old age isn't for sissies!
