MISSIONARY UPDATE: DAVE + DEBBIE BOCHMAN

LOCATION: USA + INTERNATIONAL

Here's what's happening in our lives:

I, Debbie, will be leading a women's UTK (Untying the Knots of the Heart) class. Thanks for your prayers as we begin Tuesday night. Debbie C. will be my co-facilitator again. I can't wait! Please pray for God's work in each of our lives and for wonderful connections.

I will continue to coordinate women's LIFT (Living in Faith Together) groups at our church. We have 15 groups with over a hundred women involved. Weekly, these groups study the Scriptures together and build solid relationships. My group had their first LIFT group on Thursday. Please pray that many more women in the church will want to be a part of these groups as we study and grow together.

I will also be attending the women's retreat on October 3. I've been asked to share about Discipleship in Community. That's what the LIFT groups are all about. Please pray for the women to catch a vision of sharing God's love in their communities. As the love of God fills our lives, it naturally overflows to those around us.

I also have had the chance to mentor a young Latina gal at Hope Family Resource Center. She stopped coming for a while and suddenly showed up last week, but has not returned since. Please pray that God would lead her to come back so she can know and feel God's love for her and her baby.

I have also been coaching an Egyptian neighbor who wants to learn English. She is very open about wanting to know more about the Bible, God and Jesus and has her husband's blessing to pursue these things, but it is head knowledge for her so far and it has not reached her heart. Please pray that I can communicate clearly (her English is very poor and Google Translate is not always easy to use) and that the other believers that are in her life can also communicate God's love to her clearly.

Dave led a couple of men's "campfire talks" this summer. One was on the topic of "Living as God's image-bearers" and the other was on a "Biblical and practical perspective on aging." Together we led a session on prayer at the 50+ retreat sponsored by our church.

Starting next week, he will be leading the book study, "Healing What's Within: Coming Home to Yourself—and to God—When You're Wounded, Weary, and Wandering" by Chuck DeGroat. This is the same book study I led last fall. We've both found the "Healing What's Within" material to be very helpful. It is an integrated, Biblically rooted approach that helps people get unstuck and continue their inner-life transformational journey. He will also be the assistant leader for the men's UTK class this fall.

Dave's biggest project right now is the rewrite of the 400-page Strategic Leadership course manual he authored a few years ago as part of the MA in Organizational Leadership curriculum for majority-world Christian Leaders across Asia, Africa, and Latin America. His aim is to produce a more accessible version for leaders who are weaker in English.

He is also beginning to prepare the materials he will teach in Ukraine and Moldova in December and in South Africa in January. We are both helping with the coordinating team planning for the Perspectives on the World Christian Movement course that will begin next January. After leading the coordinating team last year, we are happy to step into a supportive role for the next cycle.

I know it may sound like we are too busy but we are trusting the Lord to help us keep a balance in our lives. Thank you for partnering with us in each of these endeavors through your prayer, support and love.

Do let us know how we can pray for you! We have been blessed to be a blessing.
