MISSIONARY UPDATE:

Douglas + Karin Domier Location: Texas

Dear MPCC,

Greetings to you in the name of Jesus, our wonderful Lord. People who pray for and financially support mission work often wonder what the work and desired outcome of the efforts/work they support might look like. As I stated in an earlier communication, the work of winning, training, and facilitating the entry of workers into effective kingdom participation and coaching/mentoring them, is a long term investment that yields great returns. This is the heartbeat and the central drive of all that Karin and I do.

We share here this case study of Jaime Jimenez that will help illustrate our work. 10 years ago, Jaime and family came from Monterrey, Mexico responding to an invite from Christ the King Presbyterian Church in Katy, TX, to establish Hispanic ministries from them. The leadership requested that he have a coach/mentor to help him acculturate and figure out ministry in the USA. Through contacts with the Houston Church Planting Network, Jaime and I made contact and he requested that I be his mentor/coach. His ministry has expanded its influence from the local church ministry to a serious multiplication ministry reaching into areas in the USA, Cuba, Mexico, and other LA countries where he has cohorts he is teaching, coaching, and mentoring in multiplication efforts. Myself, and 2 other missional people form an "advisory team" for him. It has been a tremendous blessing to walk with Jaime over these past 10 years and see how God has shaped and directed him and his family. A long term investment that is bringing very good returns. This is what we do in the Houston area. We have another 15 guys we work with in this way, to one degree or another.

All our ministry lives we have focused on bi-vocation/co-vocational ministry convinced that it is the only way the gospel can be delivered to the unreached people of the world. Jaime has fully captured the vision and has committed his life to this approach.
