MISSIONARY UPDATE: DWIGHT + MARY KAY MARTIN

LOCATION: THAILAND

Testimony from: Suk Maitri, Age 58

My life hasn't been particularly easy. I'm just an ordinary woman who has had to work hard to support my family and take on many responsibilities since I was young—and that hasn't changed to this day.

For the past several years, I have to admit: I have been deeply worried about finances. There are endless expenses—food, electricity, medicine, transportation. Some months, I barely have enough to get by. Sometimes, I've had to borrow money or cut out essentials. I've spent many nights sitting alone, wondering, "How am I going to keep going?" The weight of it all has been crushing. I didn't want to tell anyone—I was afraid of becoming a burden. Some nights, I cried in silence. Other times, I pressured myself so much that it became overwhelming. At my lowest point, I even thought, "If life is going to be this hard, why was I born?"

But Jesus didn't let me stay in that darkness for long. One day, a neighbor invited me to a small church in our village. I went—not expecting anything—just hoping for a break from my endless cycle of thoughts. That day, I heard the words of Jesus: **"Do not worry about what you will eat, drink, or wear... For your heavenly Father knows that you need these things."** (Matthew 6:31–32)

I couldn't hold back my tears. It felt as if Jesus was speaking **directly** to me—straight to the burden I had carried in my heart for so long. That night, I prayed for the first time in my life: "Jesus, help me. I'm exhausted... Let me know You."

And He answered—not with a sudden fortune, but with **peace** in my heart. For the first time, I felt a calmness I had never known before. Instead of constantly worrying about money, I started to notice how Jesus was working in my life. Unexpected help came my way. I received small streams of income from places I never imagined. Sometimes, even when my income was little, **Jesus made sure I always had enough.** That was when I began to truly believe—Jesus is **the one who provides**.

I'm still not rich. I still have to carefully manage my expenses each month. But **my heart has changed.** What was once filled with fear, stress, and anxiety is now overflowing with peace, hope, and confidence—because I know Jesus will never leave me. I thank Him—not just for changing my situation, but for **changing my heart.** He has strengthened me and taught me to trust in Him completely.
