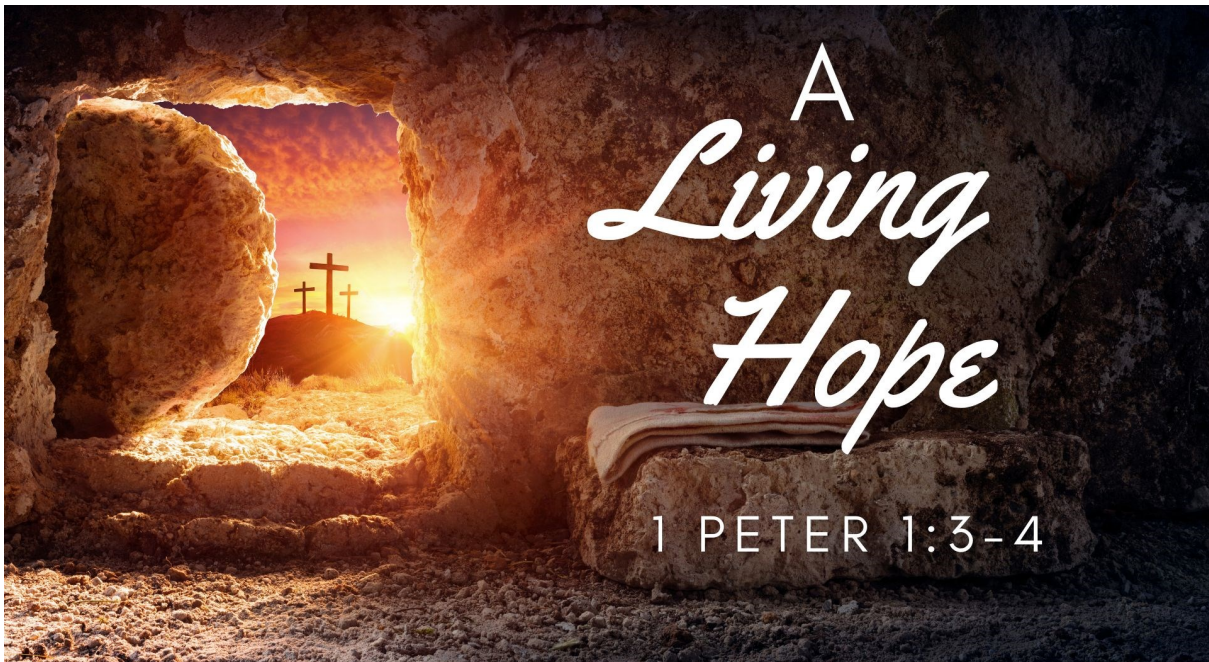

MISSIONARY UPDATE: ALEX + LYNETTE WEIR

LOCATION: USA, ASIA, + SOUTH AMERICA

Dear friends and family,

We trust that this new year has begun well for you.

Picking up where we left off from our last letter (end of October), we're excited to share that it's been a blessing to have modern technology like WhatsApp on our phones. This app has enabled frequent voice and text communications to encourage the workers who began their personal relationships with Jesus on the Hospital Vozandes outpatient construction project in Quito, Ecuador. Jorge, who shared with about 80 of his work colleagues within 20 hours of his decision to invite Jesus into his life, has continued sharing his decision with family and friends. Recently, he asked for a recommendation of an evangelical Bible teaching church that he could take his whole family to in North Guayaquil. Thank you for continuing to pray for these guys and their families.

With the construction of the new tower complete, the outpatient numbers are increasing monthly. In January alone, 17,102 outpatients were seen which means chaplains have more opportunities to minister. Remodel plans are being developed now to remodel the old front area of the hospital into a bigger Emergency Department on ground floor and a bigger Intensive Care Unit and more patient rooms on 2nd and 3rd floors.

Lord willing, we will return to Ecuador mid-March to help with the hospital remodel project and other projects on the mission compound. We look forward to being able to follow up face to face with many of the construction workers. Please continue to pray for our Ecuador entry visa situation. We have been advised to enter on a tourist visa in March and discuss current visa options with the mission's legal representative.

Our Home Ministry Assignment (furlough) of just over three months in New Zealand is now over, and the time was a blessing. Due to not arriving in New Zealand until November 1, we had scheduled meetings through November until mid-December. We were able to take a couple of weeks to rest and spend time with family over Christmas and New Years before getting back on the road to visit many friends and family individually. We thank God for this time of refreshment and hearing how God has been working in NZ. We were also blessed to share what God has been and is continuing to do in Ecuador and other places around the world through the ministry of Reach Beyond.

Thank you for your continued prayers and financial support. We appreciate you!
