MISSIONARY UPDATE: DOUGLAS + KAREN DOMIER

LOCATION: TEXAS

Greetings to you from "Hurricane Alley." We live in the center of the corridor where the hurricanes come inland from the Gulf. So far, all is well. We have two months more of the period when most sting hurricanes develop. Please pray for safety and a light season.

Ministry has changed a lot since Covid 19 and the massive illegal immigration. ICE activities have the illegals keeping a very low profile. Many are volunteering to deport with hope they can have a chance to return to the USA via legal channels. Please pray for wisdom in our approach as we adapt to the realities of this situation. Hispanics that are legally in the country do not appreciate all the illegals who are taking jobs away from them. This tension is very real in ministry settings. Our church plants and established churches continue to reach the lost and disciple them and continue on both numerical and spiritual growth patterns.

Co-vocational ministry has become the norm for establishing stable ministries among Hispanics. They work a secular job to provide for their families and do church planting and pastoring simultaneously. That is how the church expanded in the early centuries. Most of the families I coach are co-vocational. Please pray for them.

Vehicle expense pretty much cleaned out my ministry travel funds. Two months ago my 2010 car blew the engine at 179k miles. We borrowed \$25k to purchase a 2020 Pacifica.

Health-wise, we are doing quite well and able to continue to develop leader support systems/coaching for our planters and pastors. Please pray for continued health and energy.

Thank you so very much for your faithful support. We appreciate you very much and we pray for you regularly.
